

MINI PONG



RULES

CONTENTS:

- 1 Gameboard
- 2 Launchers
- 25 Cups (10 per side, plus 5 extra)
- 1 Ball/String combo tethered to round base
- 1 Mesh bag to carry contents

SETTING UP

- Put 10 cups in recessed holes in a pyramid formation on each side of the gameboard. Fill each cup with a liquid of your choice.
- Press the round base of the ball/string combo into the recessed circle in the middle of the board.
- Place a launcher in an end hole on each side of the board.
- Take turns shooting the ball into your opponent's cups using the launcher. Place the ball on the top of the launcher, pull back the top of the launcher with your finger, and release to shoot. The first team to make a shot will start the game.

HOW TO PLAY

- Each team gets two shots per turn. If the ball lands in a cup, the opponent must pull THAT cup from their side of the board AFTER the turn is over.
- Here are the instructions for most scenarios:
 - **1 ball made:** Drink what is in that cup and remove it from the board.
 - **2 balls made:** Remove the 2 cups and drink their contents. The team gets to shoot again.
 - **2 balls made (same cup):** Remove and drink from *that* cup, plus 2 others. The team shoots again.
 - **3 balls made:** Remove and drink from the 3 cups.

RULES

- Launchers can be moved between the three holes, but must remain in that hole throughout the turn.
- Two re-racks are allowed per team/per game. The shooting team must request a re-rack before they begin their turn. The opponent must then consolidate their cups on the board as requested by the shooting team.
- Bounces count the same as a normal shot.

ENDING THE GAME

- The first team to remove all of their opponent's cups from the board wins the game.
- Once a team makes the last cup, their opponent gets a chance for a rebuttal. However, if the shooting team makes both their balls in the last cup, they win straight up - with no chance for a rebuttal.
- For the rebuttal, each player shoots until they miss. If the rebutting team makes all of the remaining cups, the game is sent into overtime.
- Overtime is played with 3 cups per side which can be placed anywhere on the board. The same ending rules apply.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wash the top of the board with mild soap and water. Do not submerge the board under water. Hand wash cups only.
